With a poem about the horrendous events in Waco, Texas and Oklahoma City, Oklahoma during the 1990s, and another dealing with the spate of school shootings and drive by drug deaths in America's cities and towns, this collection is not for the feint of heart. Still, it marks an important turning point both philosophically and structurally in the poet's overall development, all while exploring some ugly subchapters in his nation's history.
